**DUES:** Homeowner semi-annual assessments were due March 1, 2022 and are now past due.

**BUDGET:** Please find enclosed the 2022 Proposed Budget.

**GARBAGE CANS** - As a reminder you must store your **garbage cans** and non-yard items out of sight, such as in the garage or to the rear of the home specifically "behind your home". All garbage cans, recycle cans and other garbage must be put away on the day of pickup.

**PARKING** - There shall be no vehicles on the street between the hours of 11 pm and 7 am. Vehicles are towed. There is also no parking on non-paved areas anywhere in Regency Place. Please remember to fill out an overnight parking form for the pool lot. This parking is for temporary overnight parking.

**POOL** - All posted rules are from the Polk County Health Department and must be followed for the pool to remain open. Please remember all children under 16 must have an adult (not a teen) to supervise them. Opening time is 8 am and closing time is sundown (time varies with time of year). You will find the current closing time posted inside the pool area near the lady's room. The pool also automatically locks at that posted time.

**STREETS** - Please drive slowly at the 15-mph speed posted to aid in the safety of all. Regency Place streets are narrow and winding with speed bumps. As a reminder, take care to roll over spike strips at exit gate. Going faster than 5 mph will result in tire damages. All warning signage is posted. Regency Place HOA is not responsible for damages.

**COMMUNITY YARD SALE** - Mark your calendars - the first community yard sale of the year will be held April 22 & 23. Entrance gates will be open for the public to access the community. Any resident may participate as well as pick and choose which day(s) and time of their personal yard sale between 8 am and 4 pm each day. Advertisements and signs will be taken care of by the community events committee.

**ARC** - Submit your ARC applications for exterior projects and **wait until approval of your application before beginning work**. For outdoor projects including but not limited to: fences, painting house (even the same color), roofing, landscaping, pools, hot tubs, satellite dishes & antennas, sheds, screenings, painting driveways (even the same color), window and door replacements, etc. Instructions, forms and even approved house colors are found on the web site at - regencyplacehomeowners.com - on the "ARC" page.
